





Our approach to investment is guided by the philosophy of Africapitalism, the private sector's commitment to Africa's development through long term investments that create economic prosperity and social wealth.









HEALTHCARE


We are committed to lighting up more homes, hospitals, and schools across Africa.












FINANCIAL SERVICES














ENERGY

Energy companies are rethinking and refining the traditional strategies of doing business in the sector. With interests in the upstream, midstream, downstream, and gas-to-power sectors of Nigeria's energy space, we have made investments with the specific objective of linking production from oil blocks into domestic value chains and encouraging value-adding activities across Africa.

As operator of OML 17, Heirs Energies has doubled production to 53,000 barrels of oil and 100 MMSCFD of gas per day.









REAL ESTATE AND HOSPITALITY

An existing shortage of residential and commercial properties, intensified by rapid urbanisation and growing incomes, is increasing the demand for real estate. With a portfolio size of over N10 billion, our property management and development company, Afriland Properties Plc, is well-positioned to take advantage of these unfolding opportunities.

It also hosts several global events including the World Economic Forum on Africa.

million unimmunised children in Africa.











